The Project includes the following Work:

- BASE BID work includes installing 8" diameter force main pipeline from the Town of Brunson to the Town of Hampton. Pipeline includes 24,245 If 8" PVC, 6,415 If 8" HDPE or 8" FPVC, 120 If 8" DIP, 60 If 8" DIP in 20" steel encasement bore-and-jack, 14 air release and vacuum valves, 60 If 12" DIP gravity sewer, 2 sewer manholes with interior epoxy coating, and addition of a 6" flow meter, vault, etc. at the influent pump station.
- ALTERNATE BID includes the downsizing of 5,480 If 8" PVC & DIP to 6" PVC & DIP
- ALTERNATE BID includes removal of 960 If of 8" PVC force main, one coating of manhole and one air release valve with the addition of 960 If of 12" PVC gravity sewer, 2 additional manholes.
- ALTERNATE BID includes the rehabilitation of 11 MHs.

Each bid must be accompanied by a 5% bid security in the proper form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. A Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required of each successful bidder.

In accordance with Section 40-11-100 of the SC Code, bids will be accepted only from properly licensed contractors for all general contracts costing \$30,000 or more and all mechanical contracts costing \$17,500 or more.

This project is being funded in whole or in part by United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the South Carolina State Revolving Fund (SRF). Bidders must comply with all applicable state and federal requirements identified in the bid documents-including Davis-Bacon and "American Iron and Steel" Provisions.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States.

The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The de-minimis and minor components waiver apply to this contract.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 90 days after the actual bid opening date.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities in bidding and to reject all Bids if it is in the Owner's best interest to do so.
