Division I of the project consists of modifications to three (3) pump stations. The work includes, but is not limited to the following components: replacement of submersible pumps, control panels, piping, and electrical components and generators at three (3) pump stations; rehabilitation of existing pump station wet wells (3); SCADA systems integration; site work; yard piping; erosion control; and all necessary appurtenances for a complete project.
